EXTRACT FROM THE CHARTERS OF THE CENTRAL ASIAN ASSOCIATION FOR EDUCATION ACCREDITATION (CAAAE)

General Provisions

The Central Asian Association for Accreditation of Education (CAAAE) is a public non-profit organization established to coordinate activities aimed at developing and ensuring the quality of education in the Central Asian region. The Association operates in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and is governed by this Charter.

Full Name and Location

The Association is registered as the "Union of Legal Entities 'Central Asian Association for Accreditation of Education'" with the abbreviated name ULE 'CAAEE'. The headquarters of the Association is located in Almaty, Kazakhstan.

Goals and Objectives

The primary goals of CAAEE are to improve the quality of educational programs and facilitate their recognition at the international level. The Association aims to:

- Accredit educational programs based on international standards.
- Provide professional training and enhance the qualifications of specialists in the field of education.
- Exchange experiences and best practices among educational institutions in the region.
- Create a platform for dialogue and cooperation between educational institutions and professional communities.

Governing Bodies

The management of the Association is carried out through two main bodies: the Supervisory Board and the Accreditation Council.

Supervisory Board performs control and advisory functions on strategic issues of the Association's activities.

Accreditation Council is responsible for methodological support, developing accreditation criteria, and making decisions on the accreditation of educational programs.

Membership

Members of CAAEE can include educational institutions, professional associations, and other legal entities interested in improving the quality of education. Members of the Association must comply with the requirements of the Charter and actively participate in the activities of the Association.

Financial Activities

The financial activities of CAAEE are carried out through membership fees, grants, donations, and income from performing work and providing services that align with the goals of the Association. The Association maintains accounting and reporting in the manner prescribed by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Legal Status

The Association possesses the rights of a legal entity, has bank accounts, seals, stamps, letterheads, and other means of visual identification registered in the prescribed manner. CAAEE has the right to enter into contracts, acquire and exercise property and personal non-property rights, assume obligations, and act as a plaintiff and defendant in court.

Amendments and Dissolution

Amendments to the founding documents are made by the general meeting of the Association's members. The activities of the Association may be terminated through reorganization or liquidation in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The decision on liquidation is made by the general meeting of the Association's members.

Final Provisions

This Charter was approved at the general meeting of the Association's members on December 26, 2023, and comes into effect upon state re-registration.
